On behalf of Holloway Terrace Homeowners Association, we would like to extend our appreciation to you and the participants in last evening's meeting; Stephanie DeWolfe, Rachel Dimond, and John Keho, with our HOA representatives, Samuel Borelli and Kathleen Ryan regarding the pending widening of Holloway Drive as it pertains to our HOA property located at 8530 Holloway Drive.

With respect to our conversation last evening, we understand that inasmuch as permits have yet to be issued to the DWP by the City of West Hollywood as well as the other contractors who will be constructing the widening of Holloway Drive, that the portion of the widening project directly impacting Holloway Terrace, as discussed, will be put on hold until a visit by the City Engineer to the Holloway Terrace site to walk through and review, with the HOA Board of Directors and consultants, the proposed street widening project as it directly impacts Holloway Terrace.

During our conversation last evening, our representatives conveyed the importance of determining the full structural impact as well as the significant safety issues and concerns which will affect all of our residents, specifically referring to the removal of the parkway just to the east of Holloway Terrace's lower garage, and elimination of all parking directly in front of Holloway Terrace and extending to the southwest corner of Holloway Drive and La Cienega.

We will also appreciate having the contact information for the person or persons the HOA should contact with respect to the timing of the street widening project in all of its different stages. We understand from the meeting last evening that all of the Holloway Terrace garage entrances will be blocked during a portion of this project and look forward to receiving additional detail on this facet of the project so we may disseminate this information to our owners.

Again, our many thanks for your interest and suggestions of last evening. We are looking forward to working with the City of West Hollywood, our home, and the developer as this project goes forward.
